KENOSHA – Effective immediately, Care-A-Van will offer trips to essential destinations at no fare. Care-A-Van, a service of Kenosha Area Transit, provides trips to individuals that are unable to ride the city’s public transit system due to a disabling condition.

Additionally, Care-A-Van, during this state of emergency, may be able to accommodate same-day trips. Usual protocol requires a reservation be made at least a day in advance. While this is still encouraged, the service is temporarily able to accommodate same day requests.

Due to reduced ridership resulting from Wisconsin Gov. Tony Ever’s “Safer at Home” order, Kenosha Area Transit will be reduce to hourly service effective Monday, March 30, 2020, until further notice. All routes will continue operating.

Riders are encouraged to adhere to the “Safer at Home” order currently in place. Citizens are directed to remain at home, except for essential needs, such as going to work, purchasing groceries or medicine or seeking health care.
